

Position: Assistant Football Coach

Job Responsibilities: The Ohio State Club Football program (NCFA) is searching for an Assistant Football Coach working primarily with Wide Receivers and/or Defensive Backs. Primary job responsibilities will include coaching the assigned position group, assisting coordinators with setting a depth chart and game planning. Additional duties, such as assisting with other position units and recruiting, may also be assigned by the head coach.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will have experience playing and/or coaching Wide Receivers and/or Defensive Backs at the high school or collegiate level. This is currently an unpaid position. Bachelor's degree preferred, but not required. The selected candidate will be required to pass a background check and complete CPR/AED certifications.

Hours: 20-25 hours per week from August through December 10
5-10 hours per week from January-July
